



Dim Tyrbinau / No Turbines

Save Brechfa Forest East & Pencarreg Mountain

We are a group of local residents coming together to stop **two** further so-called 'green' industrial windfarm developments planned on our doorsteps. Alltwalis and Brechfa have already been established so we know the effect they have had and the damage they can do. We are not opposed to green energy solutions but they should be in proportion and in unpopulated areas.

Glyn Cothi Industrial Windfarm (Brechfa Forest East) - plans **27 x 230m/750ft turbines** - Proposed by a company formed by the Welsh Government. It will be seen on hilltops surrounding Rhydcymerau, Brechfa, Abergorlech and Llanybydder. The turbines will be within 2k of 242 homes.

Nant Ceiment Energy Park (Pencarreg Mountain) - plans an energy park, including **13 turbines, pylons, solar panels and large battery storage units** - Proposed by Bute Energy. It will be seen on hilltops surrounding Llanybydder, Lampeter and Rhydcymerau.

- **COUNTRYSIDE IMPACT** - The destruction of swathes of countryside to install service roads for construction and transportation. The construction stage takes around 2 years. The massive 87m turbine blades last around 25 years and cannot be recycled. Each base requires around 3 - 4 thousand tons of concrete and locally quarried stone that will be gouged out of the hillsides. The bases would remain in place for eternity, leaching chemicals into the ground and water table.

These types of developments also create a possibility of flooding, lightning strikes and toxic battery fires.

- **HUMAN IMPACT** - There have been many studies on the impact on people living in close proximity to turbines. Reports suggest negative impacts due to flicker, noise, vibration, lights and disruption to daily life. Therefore, some people will find their physical and mental health affected.
- **OTHER IMPORTANT AREAS AFFECTED** - The flora and fauna, the local economy, tourism, leisure, culture, farming and the ability to sell property.
- **NO CHEAPER ENERGY!** - If too much power is produced the turbines get turned off and a constraint payment is paid to the company which contributes to higher electricity bills.
- **UNNECESSARY INDUSTRIALISATION** - Wales currently exports around 40% of its "green" electricity to the National Grid to be used around the UK. The Welsh Government has removed many legal obstacles in order to speed up approval for widespread industrialisation across Wales, taking advantage of this 'gold rush'. Many of these schemes are for the financial benefit of companies, their associated advisors and shareholders who are not based in Wales. Yes, it may improve the Welsh economy, but at what cost? **Wales is not for sale!**

As the Welsh elections are in May next year, now is the time to write to your politicians. You can use the points above as a guide to writing your letter. There are more ideas online.

Achub Coedwig Dwyrain Brechfa a Mynydd Pencarreg

Rydym yn grŵp o drigolion lleol yn dod ynghyd i atal dau ddatblygiad gwynt pellach, a elwir yn 'wyrdd', sydd ar fin cael eu hadeiladu ar ein stepan drws. Mae Alltwalis a Brechfa eisoes wedi'u sefydlu felly rydym yn gwybod yr effaith a'r difrod y gallant ei achosi. Nid ydym yn erbyn datrysiad ynni gwyrdd, ond dylent fod yn gymesur ac mewn ardaloedd diboblog.

Glyn Cothi (Coedwig Dwyrain Brechfa) – cynlluniau ar gyfer 27 tyrbin 230m/750tr – Cynigiwyd gan gwmni a grëwyd gan Lywodraeth Cymru. Fe'i gwelir ar benau bryniau o amgylch Rhydcymerau, Brechfa, Abergorlech a Llanybydder. Bydd y tyrbinau o fewn 2 km i 242 o gartrefi.

Nant Ceiment (Mynydd Pencarreg) – cynlluniau ar gyfer parc ynni, gan gynnwys 13 tyrbin, peilonau, paneli solar a chyfleusterau storio batris mawr – Cynigiwyd gan Bute Energy. Fe'i gwelir ar benau bryniau o amgylch Llanybydder, Lampeter a Rhydcymerau.

EFFAITH AR YR ARDAL WLEDIG – Dinistrio darnau helaeth o gefn gwlad i osod ffyrdd gwasanaeth ar gyfer adeiladu a chludo. Mae llafnau tyrbin enfawr 87m ond yn para 25 mlynedd ac ni ellir eu hailgylchu. Mae pob sylfaen yn gofyn tua 3-4 mil o dunelli o goncrid a bydd carreg leol yn cael ei thynnu o'r bryniau. Bydd y sylfeini'n aros am dragwyddoldeb, gan ollwng cemegion i'r pridd a'r tabl dŵr. Mae'r mathau hyn o ddatblygiadau hefyd yn creu'r posibilrwydd o lifogydd, mellt a than a batris gwenwynig.

EFFAITH AR BOBL – Mae sawl astudiaeth wedi'u cynnal ar yr effaith ar bobl sy'n byw'n agos at dyrbinau. Mae adroddiadau'n awgrymu effeithiau negyddol oherwydd fflachio, sŵn, dirgryniad, goleuadau ac aflonyddwch ar fywyd bob dydd. O ganlyniad, bydd rhai pobl yn profi effeithiau ar eu hiechyd corfforol a meddyliol.

MEYSYDD PWYSIG ERAILL SY'N GAEL EU HEFFEITHIO – Y planhigion a'r anifeiliaid, yr economi leol, twristiaeth, hamdden, diwylliant, ffermio a'r gallu i werthu eiddo.

DIM TRYDAN RHATACH! – Os cynhyrchir gormod o bŵer cânt eu diffodd a bydd y cwmni'n codi tâl cyfyngu, sy'n cyfrannu at filiau trydan uwch.

DIWYDIANNU ANGENRHEIDIOL – Mae gan Gymru eisoes fwy o ffermydd gwynt a solar nag sydd eu hangen i bweru'r wlad. Ar hyn o bryd rydym yn allforio tua 40% o'n "hynni gwyrdd". Mae Llywodraeth Cymru wedi dileu llawer o rwystrau cyfreithiol er mwyn cyflymu cymeradwyaeth ar gyfer diwydiannu eang ar draws Cymru, gan fanteisio ar y 'rhuthr aur' hwn.
